Alzheimer's San Diego:

Mission- to eliminate Alzheimer's disease through research and help those affected; reduce the risk of dementia through brain health. **Request-** provide funds to help support free programs, which provide a lifeline for local families facing the Alzheimer's crisis.

Elderhelp:

Mission- to provide personalized services and information that helps seniors remain independent in their own homes. **Request-** to provide funds for the scholarship fund which supports the "Concierge Club," a program which provides care management, health advocacy, referrals and more for San Diego's most vulnerable seniors.

Goodwill Industries of San Diego County:

Mission- to help people with disabilities and other barriers to employment get jobs by developing their skills and work habits for training and real work. **Request-** to provide computer workstations for staff and volunteers.

MANA de San Diego:

Mission- to empower Latinas through education, leadership development, community service and advocacy. **Request-** to support the leadership mentor program for Latinas, ages 12-18. Girls are matched with professional women for 1 year with the goal of pursuing higher education and establishing career goals.

Monarch School:

Mission- to educate students impacted by homelessness, impart hope for a future, and help them develop necessary skills. **Request-** funds to support student internships and/or college scholarships within Monarch's College and Career Development Program.

Point Loma High School Band:

Mission- to connect students, school and the community through music. **Request-** to provide funds to support the purchase of instruments, music, uniforms and/or travel to events.

Promising Futures:

Mission- to provide quality residential day treatment for individuals with severe communication and behavior challenges. **Request-** to fund the professional promotion, display, and creation of artworks, and items produced by clients in the Promising Futures art studio and in vocational programs. Note: they helped at last year's Rummage Sale.

San Diego Woodturners Association:

Mission- to help Veterans suffering physical and mental issues recover their sense of worth. **Request-** to provide funds to purchase supplies and tools to support the “Turn Around for Vets” program.

Support the Enlisted Project (STEP):

Mission- to provide active duty and veteran families financial grants in times of crisis, and provide counseling to further financial self-sufficiency. **Request-** provide funds to support the program that assists families in their transition from military to civilian life.

Tender Loving Canines:

Mission- to build bridges to independence by transforming lives of Wounded Warriors and autistic individuals; it also saves shelter dogs and helps prison inmates who train them.

Request- provide funds for veterinarian care, dog food, training treats, and for acquiring dog(s) to train.

Travis Manion Foundation:

Mission- assists veterans and families of the fallen. It engages them in all stages of their personal journeys and offers opportunities to empower them to reach their goals. **Request-** fund veterans and their families in their transition from military to civilian life.
